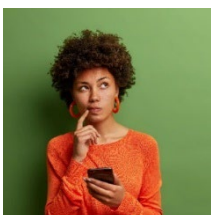

Introduction



TfL would like improve Upper Richmond Road and the area around **East Putney Station**.



These changes are needed to improve the area around **East Putney station** for pedestrians and cyclists.



You can give us your feedback on the possible changes for **six weeks** from:



Monday 20 January 2025

to



Monday 3 March 2025.



Why make changes on Upper Richmond Road are the area around East Putney station?



The possible changes to Upper Richmond Road supports the work of TfL and the Mayor of London.



The Mayor of London wants:

- less pollution



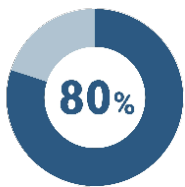
- more people using public transport



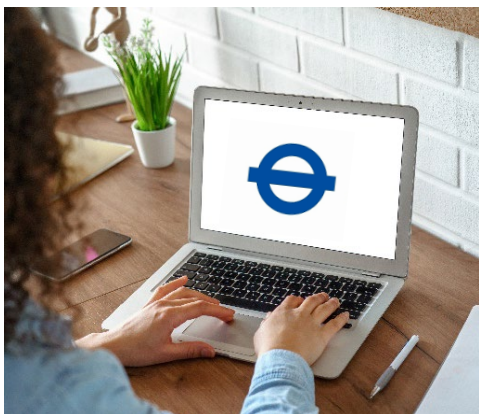
- to make our streets safer and healthier.



The possible changes in **East Putney** support one of the goals in the **Mayor's Transport Strategy**.



The goal is for **eighty per cent** of journeys to be made by walking, cycling or public transport **by 2041**.

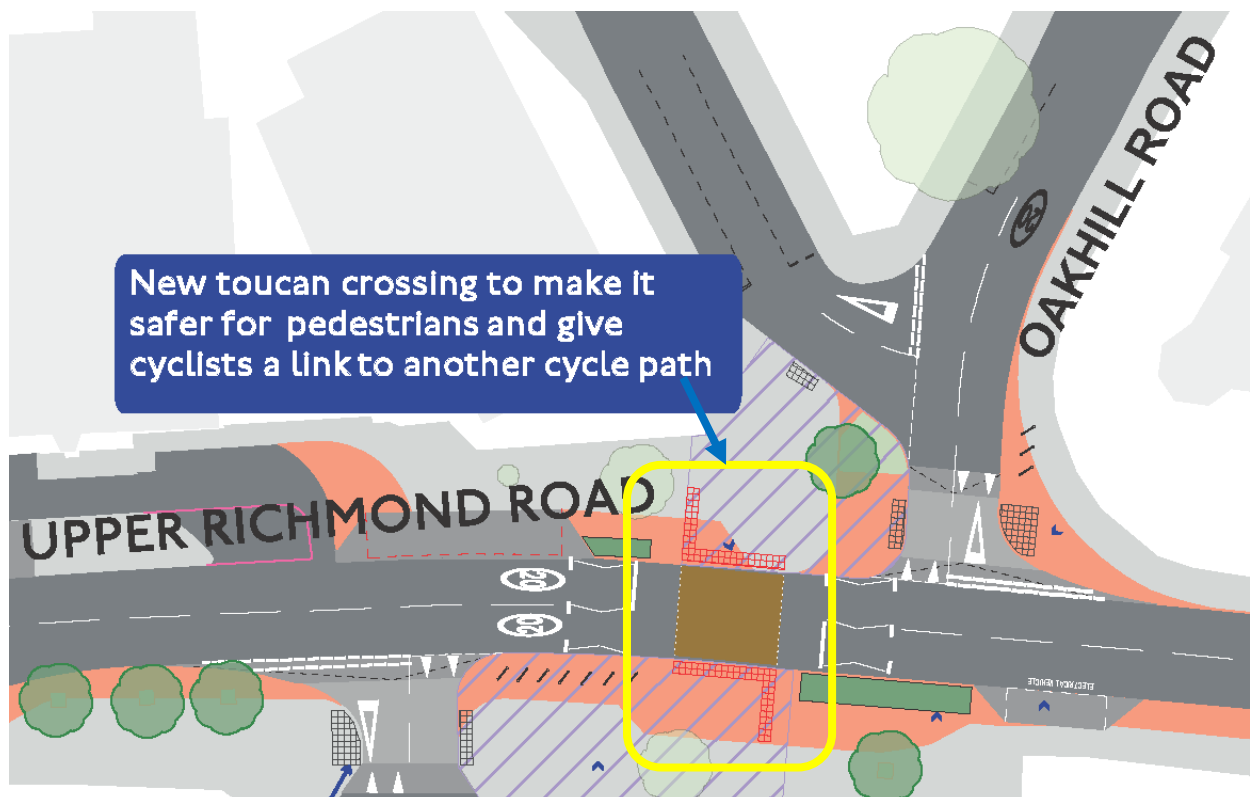

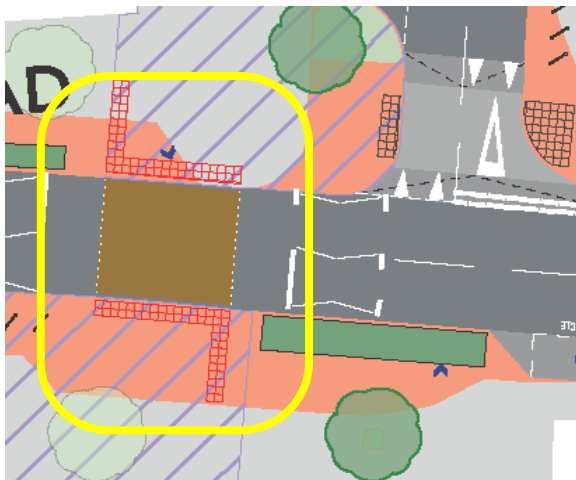
What are the possible changes on Upper Richmond Road and around East Putney station?

A new Toucan crossing could be built across Upper Richmond Road close to Oakhill Road.



Toucan crossings allow cyclists and pedestrians to cross the road at the same time.

There will be more space for cyclists and pedestrians close to Keswick Road.



This space for cyclists and pedestrians will join up with:

- the **new toucan crossing**
- the space for cyclists and pedestrians already on Oakhill Road.



The pedestrian crossing with signals already on Upper Richmond Road would be moved.



This pedestrian crossing would move:

- from outside Wandsworth County Court

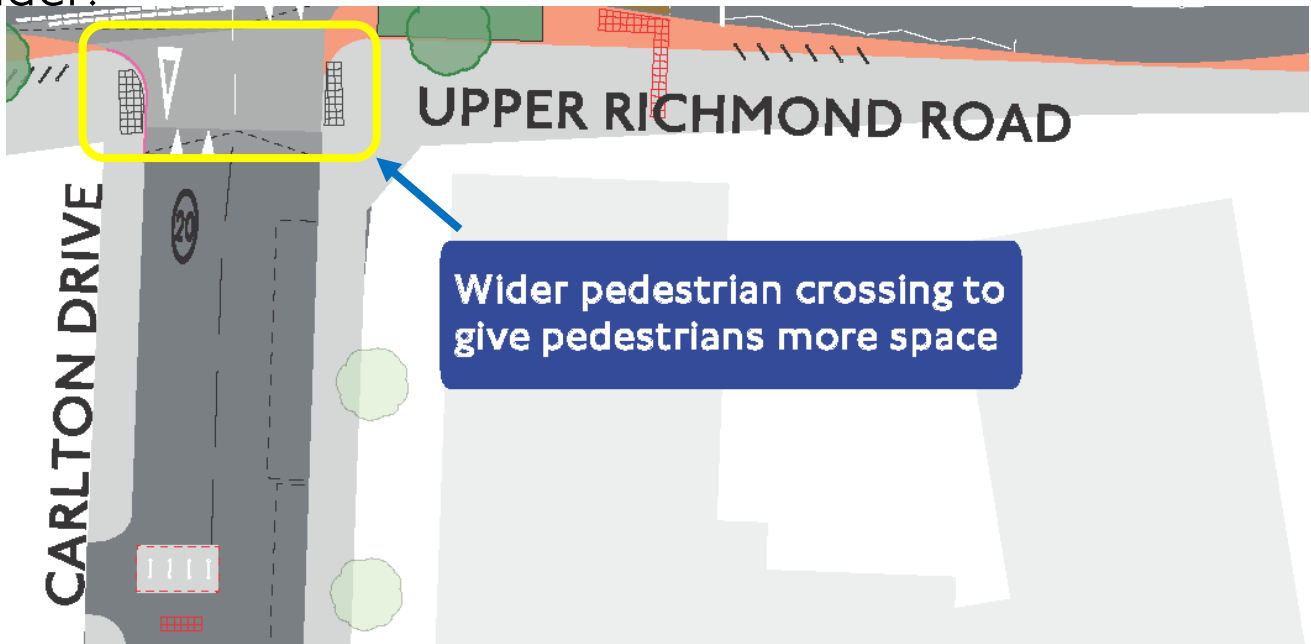


- to outside East Putney Station.



This is because most people want to cross the road at East Putney station.

The pedestrian crossing on Carlton Drive would be made wider.



This would give pedestrians more space to walk around.



It would also make it quicker and easier to cross the road.



A new taxi rank would be built outside East Putney Station.



Currently the area outside the East Putney station is a **drop off only** parking bay.



We would make the current pedestrian areas bigger to give pedestrians more space to walk around.



We would build **new cycle stands** on the new pavement outside 108 Upper Richmond Road.



New trees and green areas would be planted around this area.



To make all these improvements we would need to **move and remove loading bays and parking bays** in the area.



We explain from **Page 13 to Page 17** which **loading bays and parking bays** could be affected.

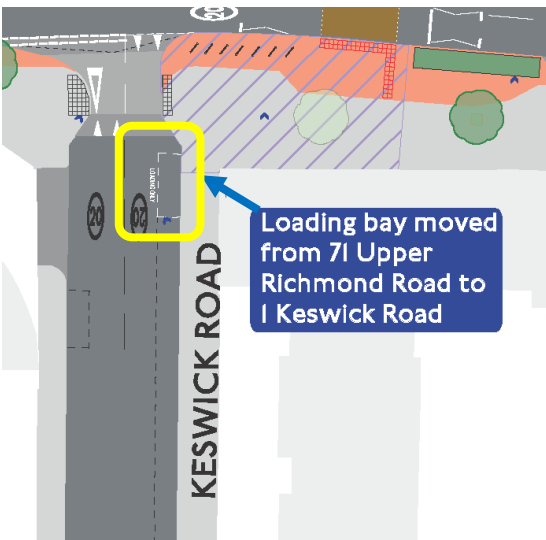


Keswick Road



The loading bay would be moved:

- from outside Millbrooke Court on 71 Upper Richmond Road



- to 1 Keswick Road.



The new loading bay would be changed from a parking bay that is already on Keswick Road.



Upper Richmond Road



A long loading bay **opposite East Putney station** and underneath the railway bridge would be removed.



Currently there is a **long** parking bay outside **124 Upper Richmond Road**.

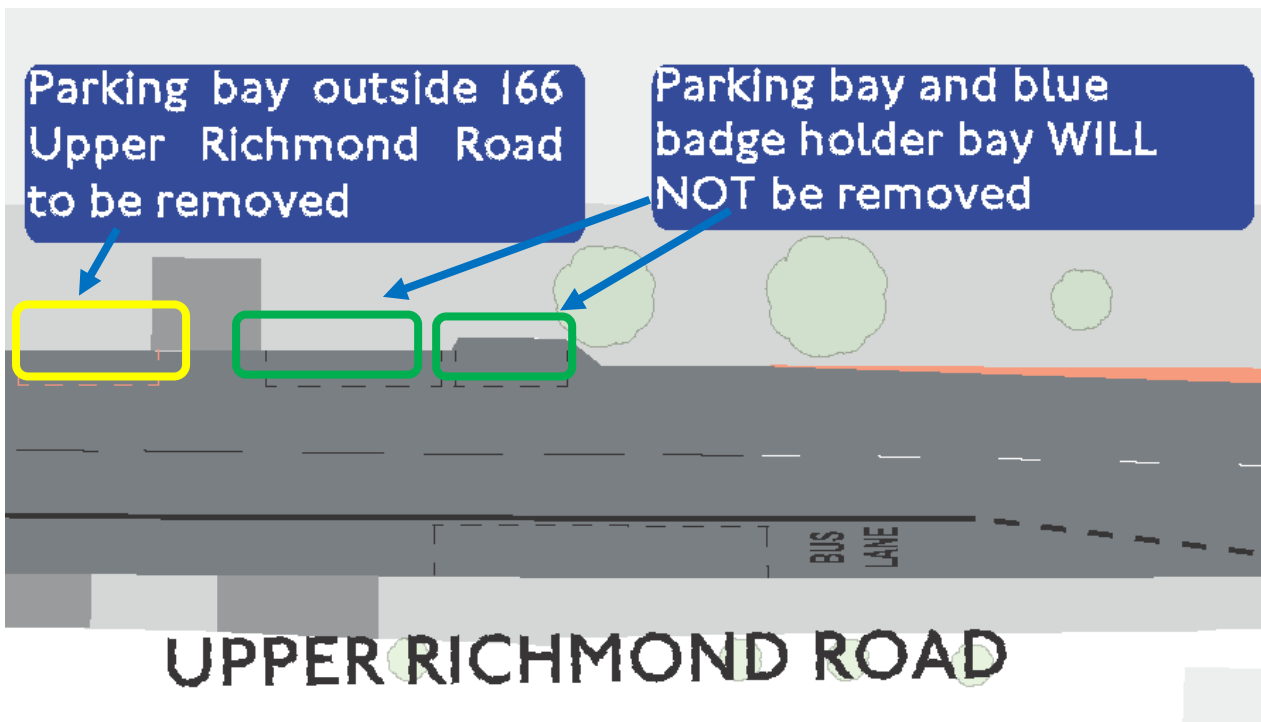


We would make this parking bay **smaller** to give pedestrians more space to walk around.



Part of this parking bay would be changed into new loading bays outside the shops.

A parking bay outside 166 Upper Richmond Road could be removed.



Parking bays close to 166 Upper Richmond Road will not be removed:

- a parking bay
- a blue badge holder bay



Outside **89 Upper Richmond Road** a long parking bay will be made smaller.

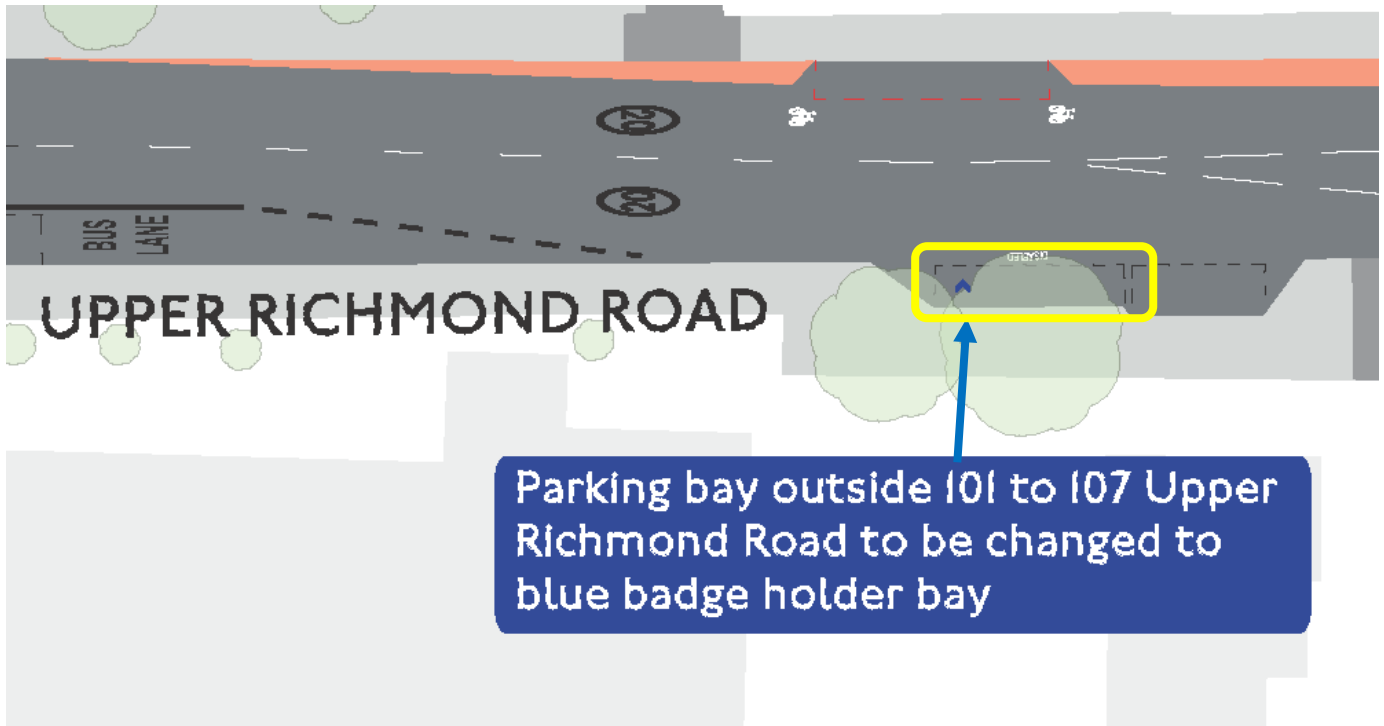


Part of this parking bay will be used for repairing cycles for hire.



An electric charging point opposite Oakhill Road would be moved along the road.

We could change a parking bay outside 101 to 107 Upper Richmond Road to a bay for blue badge holders.





We will need to get funding before we can start the improvements in the area.

How could the possible changes affect you?



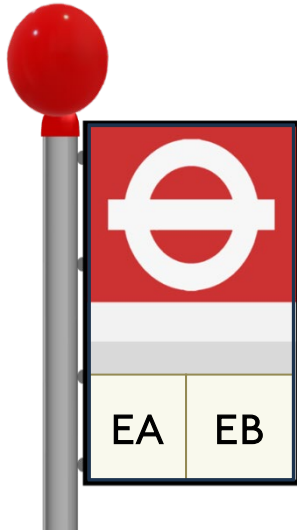
If you are walking or cycling



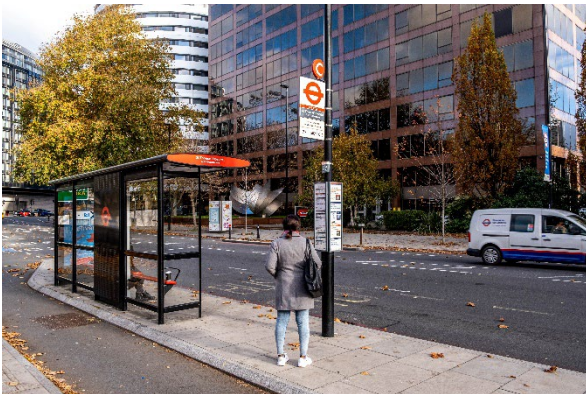
If you are walking or cycling to East Putney station your journey should be easier, safer and more pleasant.



If you are travelling by bus



There could be more space to wait at bus stops EA and EB.



This should make it more pleasant when waiting for a bus at these bus stops.



If you are travelling by car, van or motorcycle



We could move or remove some parking bays and loading bays.



Some drivers may need to walk further to or from their vehicle if they use the parking bays around East Putney station.

To improve how we get feedback from London's deaf community we are trying out a British Sign Language or BSL service to get your feedback.



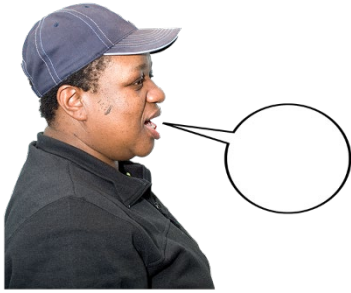
This will allow the TfL consultation lead to have a two-way BSL discussion about the changes in the East Putney area with a BSL signer.

The report will come out **summer 2025** and will include:



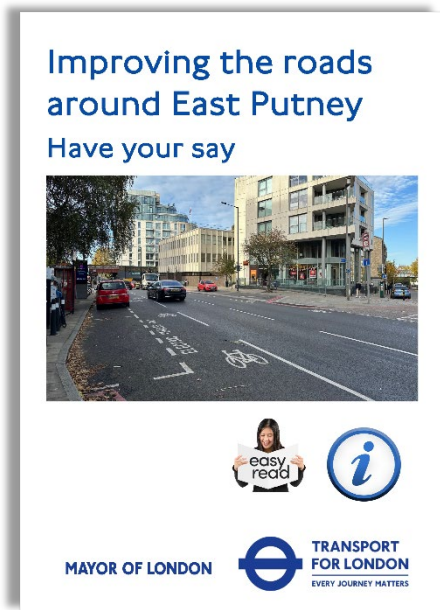
- TfL's reply to your feedback

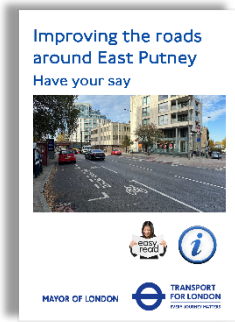

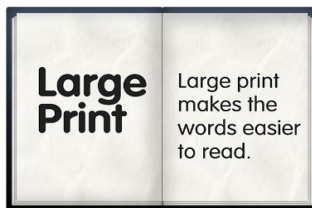

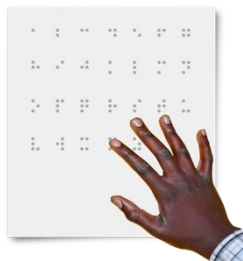
